Middle School Activities

VMS offers students opportunities to make life-long friends and to get to know their teachers, school and community through the sharing of common interests. Students have the opportunity to take part in a wide range of extra-curricular activities, including: **Band, Jazz Band, and Choir:** offered as elective classes, these groups give performances several times each year as well as participate in regional festivals.

Interscholastic Sports: Football and Cheerleading (available to 8th grade students only) Basketball, Volleyball, Track, Wrestling and Cross Country. These are available to 7th and 8th graders throughout the year.

Intramural Athletics: open to all grades and abilities after school. Games include 3 on 3 basketball and volleyball.

Student Leadership : Meets with staff advisors and helps to develop and run student activities.

School Yearbook: works to plan and layout the annual yearbook.

After School Activities include:

- Math Counts Team: Students compete with other schools in tournaments that feature complex problem solving.
- Art Break: Students interested in stretching themselves artistically work with many different types of media.
- Theatre Games: Drama, acting exercises and games are played to enhance skills.

Social Activities include: dances (grades 7 & 8), activity nights (6th grade), roller skating (6th grade) and the annual Lock-In (all grades).

School clubs – include ski club, homework club, FFA, bowling club, world language club, and scrapbook club

Talent Show – held in the spring. Tryouts are open to all grades.

Trips and in-school activities include: All grades to a Kalamazoo Kings Baseball Game, Straight A Assemblies/Activities, 6th grade camp, 7th grade Formula K Trip and 8th grade Cedar Point trip.
